

Libby's Legacy Breast Cancer Foundation: At A Glance

Libby's Legacy is a volunteer-driven 501(c)(3) charity who provides comprehensive services to the underserved through education, mammograms, and patient navigation on the journey from diagnosis to survivorship with the compassion to ensure no one fights alone. Founded in 2007 by Robin Maynard in honor of her mother, Libby's Legacy has provided over 6,000 Breast Health services, diagnosed/navigated over 120 breast cancer patients, and awarded 11 LIVE BIG cruises to stage IV cancer patients.

Main programs:

- Cancer Screening Initiative (CSI)/Mammogram Access Project (MAP): Provides
 free mammograms and follow up breast health services such as sonograms, and
 biopsies to underserved women and men in the Central Florida Community via
 stand alone office or mobile mammography unit. Have you had your
 mammogram this year?
- Patient Advocate Liaison Services (PALS): This program advocates on behalf of breast cancer patients and connects them to treatment and surgery. The program also offers emotional support by offering to attend doctor/treatment and surgery appointments, Through the PALS program, each patient has had the comfort of knowing someone was with them to hold their hand and fight for them throughout their breast cancer journey and into survivorship.
- Pink Ribbon Garden (PRG): The Pink Ribbon Garden is a 29' x 17' pink raised bed garden box in the shape of an awareness ribbon. The first debuted in Orlando and is co-founded by Melissa Etheridge, a Grammy Award Winning singersongwriter, breast cancer survivor, and clean-living proponent. This project offers breast cancer survivors, and their families, fresh, organic food. Survivors plant, tend, and harvest the garden with a "Grow One, Give One" approach; for each bag of food they harvest, they give a bag to a patient currently in treatment. More gardens are opening nationally in 2018-2019.
- LIVE BIG: This program provides Stage IV breast cancer survivors with a free memory making trip to create cherished memories with family, because it's not just about surviving, but living! So far, Libby's Legacy has given 11Live Big trips to breast cancer survivors to take the cruise Robin and her mom planned but never got to fulfill.

Each year Libby's Legacy Breast Cancer Foundation continues to advance our mission to provide comprehensive breast health care to the underserved through great community support and growing partnerships. Thank you for your inquiry and your desire to give and grow with us.
